




SAVE INDIA FROM FASCISM

Develop a Relationship with Your Elected Leaders:

Justice For All has been able to deliver 52,000 calls last year to elected leaders. That helped us pass bills which put pressure on China for Uyghur Muslims. Your relationship matters

1. When was the last time you met your elected leader or their staff?
2. Did you ever visit their local office?
3. Would you like training in this regard?

Impose targeted sanctions on Indian government agencies and officials responsible for severe violations of religious freedom by freezing those individuals' assets and/or barring their entry into the United States (USCIRF)
